The First Day of School:

Class lists

Our Daily Timetable:

Students must be in their homeroom by no later than 8:30 a.m. They may not enter the school before 8:20 a.m. unless they are involved in a before-school activity. There are two nutrition breaks during the day. Students eat in the lunchroom and then go outside or to intramural clubs/activities. We dismiss at 2:50 p.m.

Busing:
